- **Ecclesiastes 12:13-14:**

¹³ Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. ¹⁴ For God shall bring *every work into judgment*, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil. (KJV).

- **Ecclesiastes 9:7:**

⁷ Go thy way, eat thy bread with joy, and drink thy wine with a merry heart; for God now accepteth *thy works*.

- **Matthew 5:16:**

¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your *good works*, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

- **Matthew 11:21:**

²¹ Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the *mighty works*, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.

- **Matthew 11:23:**

²³ And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if the *mighty works*, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.

- **Matthew 16:27:**

²⁷ For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward **every man according to his works**.

- **Matthew 23:3, 5:**

³ All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do; but do not ye after their *works*: for they say, and do not. ⁵ But all their *works* they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the borders of their garments,

- **John 6:28:**

²⁸ Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might *work the works of God*?

- **John 7:3:**

³ His brethren therefore said unto him, Depart hence, and go into Judaea, that thy disciples also may see the *works that thou doest*.

- **John 14:12:**

¹² Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, *the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do*; because I go unto my Father.

- **Acts 9:36:**

³⁶ Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of *good works* and alms deeds which she did..

- **Acts 26:20:**

²⁰ But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and *do works meet for repentance*.

- **Romans 13:3,12:**

³For rulers are not a terror to *good works*, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? *do that which is good*, and thou shalt have praise of the same: ¹²The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore *cast off the works of darkness*, and let us put on the armour of light.

- **2 Corinthians 11:15:**

¹⁵ Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their *works*.

- **Galatians 2:16:**

¹⁶Knowing that a *man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ*, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

- **Galatians 3:10:**

¹⁰For as many as are of *the works of the law are under the curse*: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.

- **Galatians 5:19-21:**

¹⁹ Now the *works of the flesh are manifest*, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, ²⁰ Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, ²¹ Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, *that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God*.

- ***Ephesians 2:9-10:**

⁹*Not of works*, lest any man should boast. ¹⁰For we are his workmanship, *created in Christ Jesus unto good works*, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

- **Ephesians 5:11:**

¹¹*And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness*, but *rather reprove them*.

- **1 Timothy 2:10:**

¹⁰But (which becometh women professing godliness) with *good works*.

- **I Timothy 5:10, 25:**

¹⁰Well reported of for *good works*; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, *if she have diligently followed every good work*.

- **1 Timothy 6:17, 18:**

¹⁷Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; ¹⁸*That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate*;

- **2 Timothy 3:17:** ¹⁷That the man of God may be perfect, *thoroughly furnished unto all good works*.

- **2 Timothy 4:14:**

¹⁴Alexander the coppersmith did me much evil: *the Lord reward him according to his works*:

- **Titus 1:16:**

¹⁶They profess that they know God; but in *works* they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good *work* reprobate.

- **Titus 2:7, 14:**

⁷In all things shewing thyself a pattern of *good works*: in doctrine shewing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, ¹⁴Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good *works*.

- **Titus 3:5, 8, 14:**

⁵Not by *works* of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; ⁸This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men. ¹⁴And let our's also learn to maintain good *works* for necessary uses, that they be not unfruitful.

- **Hebrews 6:1:**

Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from *dead works*, and of faith toward God,

- **Hebrews 10:4:**

²⁴*And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works*:

- **James 2:14, 17, 18, 20 21-26:**

¹⁴What doth it profit, my brethren, though a man say he hath faith, and have not *works*? can faith save him? ¹⁷Even so faith, if it hath not *works*, is dead, being alone. ¹⁸Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: *shew me thy faith without thy works*, and I will shew thee my faith by my *works*. ²⁰But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without *works* is dead? ²¹Was not Abraham our father justified by *works*, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? ²²Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and *by works* was faith made perfect? ²⁴Ye see then how that by *works* a man is justified, and not by faith only. ²⁵Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by *works*, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way? ²⁶For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without *works* is dead also.

- **James 3:13:**

¹³Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? *let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom*.

- **1 Peter 2:12:**

¹²Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, *they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation*.

- **1 John 3:8:** ⁸He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he *might destroy the works* of the devil.

- **Revelation 2:5:**

⁵Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and *do the first works*; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

- **Revelation 2:13, 19:**

¹³*I know thy works*, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth. ¹⁹I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first. ²³And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you *according to your works*. ²⁶*And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:*

- **Revelation 3:1, 2:**

¹And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; *I know thy works*, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead. ²Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: *for I have not found thy works perfect before God.*

- **Revelation 9:20:**

²⁰And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet *repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:*

- **Revelation 14:13:**

¹³And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their *works do follow them.*

- **Revelation 15:13:**

³And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, *Great and marvellous are thy works*, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.

- **Revelation 18:6:**

⁶Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her *works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.*

- **Revelation 20: 12, 13:**

¹²And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, *according to their works*. ¹³And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: *and they were judged every man according to their works.*¹
