

So You Are Anti-Rapture?

If you answer “yes”, and you believe every Christian must go through this demonic time of terror—the same as those who are lost—and are rebellious to even the thoughts of holiness and righteousness in serving Jesus—then please allow me to make some recommendations to help you get there.

1. Continue exactly the direction you are going, refusing to consider a walk in His Spirit.
2. Ignore Jesus’ statement, “*If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily (every day), and follow Me*”. (Luke 9:23).
3. Do not learn to use Christ-given, powerful weapons of spiritual warfare in overcoming sin.
4. Do not hunger for more of Jesus in your life, because you do not believe that’s possible.
5. Enjoy more of the things of the world than you enjoy of the things of God. He’s no longer expecting much of you *since you were saved*.
6. Keep believing there’s no way you can defeat the wiles of the enemy of your soul.
7. Forget about “watching for His coming for the church” because that cannot happen.
8. Believe Jesus never said He would make a way for His church to *escape* the Tribulation.

(“For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to *escape* all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.”).

9. Do not watch and pray *always* that you are accounted worthy to *escape* the Tribulation.
10. Do not keep the word of His patience (Don’t remain strong in faith and obedient to the end; being knowledgeable in His Word.).

(“Because thou hast kept the word of My patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth. Behold, I will come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.”)

NOTE: Both red-letter “Jesus statements” above *mention negatively all those that dwell on earth!*

11. Ignore what Paul said, “¹⁴*For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.*” (Romans 6:14).
12. Do not worry about anything because God considers you to be an overcomer, no matter how.
13. You believe there must be some mistake in both Jesus’ statements. He was simply misquoted; or maybe the Word was mistranslated(??)

Friend, God wasn’t misquoted; neither was the Word of God mistranslated. The real truth is that if you *studied the Word* as He wants you to, you would be—by now—getting much deeper in His revelations *in the Word*. Then you would have the faith in the Word to pray for deeper truths to come to you. The Holy Spirit is willing if you are.
